Category: Literacy



Title of Lesson: Reflecting on Text and Writing a Book Review

Goals/Objectives: To think more deeply about what we are reading, and write a review for an audience.

Materials Needed:

Book, pencil, paper

Task Instructions:

Continue to read for at least 30 minutes each day.

Reflect on what you are reading through talking with someone in your family about your reading, or writing your thoughts on the following questions:

- What do you like about what you are reading?
- What connections are you making to the text?
- What questions do you have about the text?
- What do you think the writer would like you to think about?

Next, write a review of the text. Consider the effectiveness of the book, your satisfaction with the development and who the intended audience is. Imagine that your review would appear in a newspaper or a magazine and write appropriately for your intended audience.
