

Art – Gr2 – Lesson 2 – Lines and Patterns

Curriculum: Art; Science

Learning Goal:

- Lines and patterns can be found in nature. You observed the lines and patterns in leaves. Identify different types of lines and patterns
- Practice fine motor control

Materials:

- Piece of paper or notebook
- Pencil, crayons or felt crayons
- Various cups, containers to trace circles

Collect some different sizes of containers to trace.

Place them on a piece of paper and trace around to create a circle. Make an odd number of circles on your piece of paper. (*This is an artistic trick that allows the eye to see beauty.)

Create a variety of design lines and patterns.

Use straight lines, zig zag lines, curvy lines, circles, ovals. See how many you can do.
