

Literacy Gr1 Lesson 3 – Chicka Chicka Boom Boom

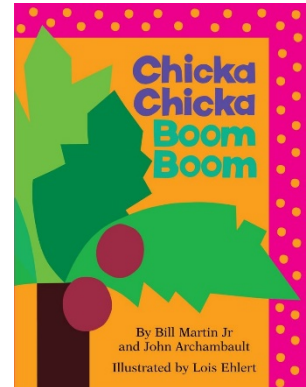
Curriculum: Literacy, Music

Learning Goals:

- Understand language features of print awareness and letter formation
- Understand that language can be a source of creativity and joy

Materials:

- Chicka Chicka Boom Boom. By Bill Martin Jr. and John Archambault <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=KAmdDqOKJWY> (this is the animated song version of the book.)
- Old magazine or puffy letters from the Dollar store (craft section)



Activity:

Sing along with the video. Identify the letters as they climb the coconut tree.

Create a picture of a coconut tree in the center of piece of paper. It has a trunk and some big leaves at the top.

Depending on the materials you collected, find letters that spell out your name to glue to the coconut tree.

What are two things that you are good at or that you like to do? Find letters that spell out those two things. Once you have one spelled out, glue that to the tree.

Then find letters for the second word and glue that somewhere on the paper.
