

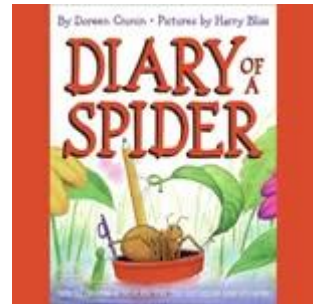
## Literacy Gr2 – Lesson 2 – Stories Have Details

Activity:

Read the book, Diary of a Spider. You might wish to read along with the words on the page. Just turn the sound off.

Answer these questions in your notebook.

- Make a list of any words you didn't know how to read. Go through the book again with the sound turned off. List any words that you had trouble. Notice the letters that make up the word. Say them over and over.
- What did you learn in the story that you thought was funny?
- Spider and Fly go to school too. What do you do in school that is different?
- Spider made up flashcards of step by step instructions for something. Think of a skill that you would like to share, how to make your bed, or how to set the table or how to ? Make up flashcards for each step. You can also write this down as a list in your notebook. Label it 1. 2. 3....

In your notebook create a diary of writing for each day. Write 2-6 sentences. You might make it funny or make it serious. Draw a picture to go with it.
