Learning Goals:

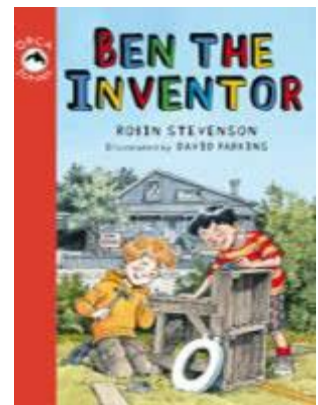
- Use prior knowledge to actively predict meaning (rereading)

Activity:

Read the book – Ben the Inventor

Use the green arrows to change pages.

Were there words you didn't know? What strategies did you use to uncover words you didn't know?

Good readers think about the story as they read. Record your thoughts in a notebook or piece of paper.

- In chapter 1, what problem faced Ben and Jack?
- In chapter 3, why do you think Ben was so upset?
- How would you feel if your best friend was moving away? What would you do?
- Chapter 4: before you read this, predict what a "stupendous plan" might be?
- Chapter 8: Ben and Jack had ideas to stop people from wanting to buy Jack's house. What ideas would you come up with to make someone not buy a house? Make a list of these in your notebook. You can compare your notes with the book.
- Stories often teaches us something. What do you think this story teaches?
