Title of Lesson: Dress for the Seasons!

Goals/Objectives:

- Identify needs and opportunities for designing, through exploration
- Generate ideas from their experiences and interests

Materials Needed:

Paper

Drawing/colouring supplies

Computer/internet access (optional)

Task Instructions: (Step by Step)

- Print out, or draw a paper doll. This can represent your child, a character from their favourite book, etc.
- Imagine where they live. Ask yourself: What type of clothing would they need to wear to stay warm in the winter? What would they wear in the summer? Autumn?
 - Once you have decided what they will need to wear, create those articles of clothing for your paper doll

Adaptations/Adjustments: (consider different environments)

- If you don't have craft supplies handy, you can write a list, or simply draw the items (without cutting out and colouring)

Extensions (Optional):

- Create a story with your doll as the main character. Write the story so that your character wears each piece of clothing.
- Where does your character live? What does their house look like? Create their house by building or drawing a picture of it.
