Learning Goals:

- Use reasoning to explore and make connections
- Develop and use multiple strategies to engage in problem solving
- Communicate mathematical thinking in many ways
- Use mathematical vocabulary and language to contribute to mathematical discussions

Materials

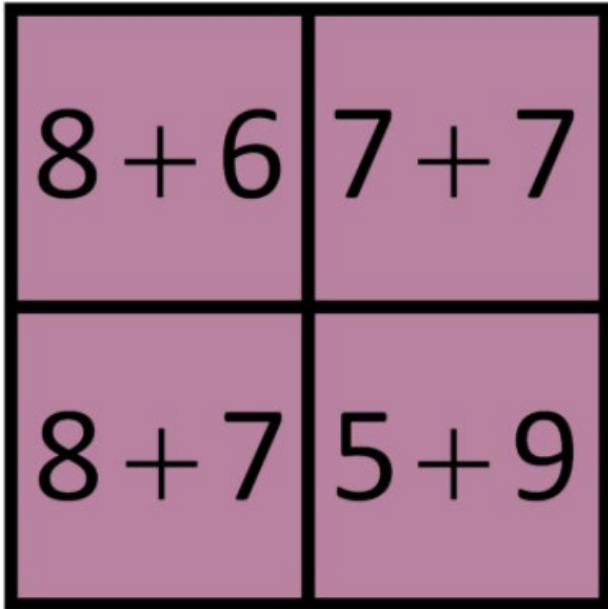
a partner (can be a grown up or peer)

- Do the same (thinking, discussion, drawing/writing) for Picture #2

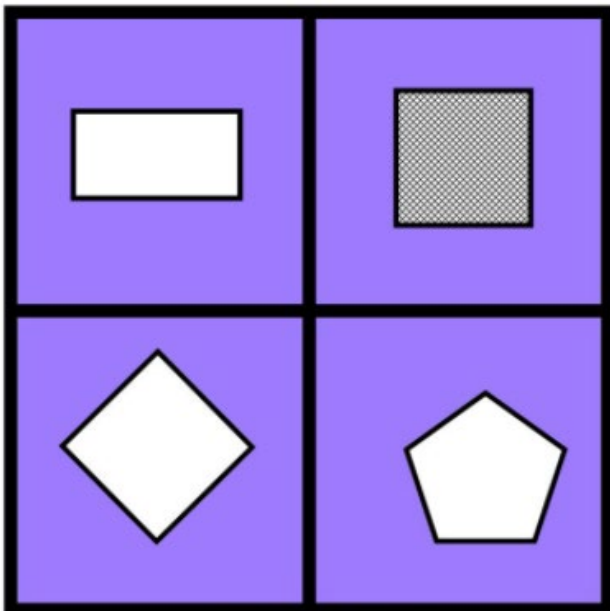
Extension: Create your own set of 4 numbers or shapes and ask partner the questions above.
