GATHER MATERIALS

- A background on which to build your story (paper, cardboard, floor, table, or outside, for example.)

READ ALONG & THINK

CREATE & SHARE

- MAKE your own story about a pumpkin using your beautiful stuff collection. It could be real or from your imagination. What material in your collection could you use to be your pumpkin? Do you have anything that is orange? If not, you can also draw and colour your pumpkin and cut it out. Who else is in your story? Where does it take place? What happens?
- PLAY with your story.
- TELL someone your story.
