


# Physical and Health Education – Weekly Health Journal

<b>Curriculum:</b> Physical and Health Education	<b>Learning Goals:</b> -Identify and apply strategies that promote mental well-being

<b>Activities</b>
<b>This week's focus: Noticing and Naming Feelings</b>

-Say: It is important for us to notice and name how we are feeling. Noticing and naming feelings will help us to promote our mental well-being. To be able to notice and name feelings we must understand specific emotions that we feel. -Listen to <a href="#">In My Heart: A Book of Feelings by: Jo Witek</a> -Say: At the end of the book the author asks, "How does your heart feel?" Your job is to create your own page for this book in your weekly health journal. -Ask: How does your heart feel? Illustrate in your weekly health journal how your heart is feeling right now. Tell your grown up what feeling you are currently experiencing and an example of how it is making your heart feel. If you are unsure... look back in the book for inspiration and examples of feelings!
<b>Extension:</b> In the lesson this week "Exploring Emotions: Emotional and Overwhelmed", you listened to <a href="#">The Boy with Big, Big Feelings by: Britney Winn Lee</a> a book about intense feelings. -Ask: How does your heart feel when you have intense feelings or are feeling overwhelmed?
