

Numeracy Grade 3 Oct 5

Activity 1: Place Value to 1000

Materials Needed:

- Handout below, 1 player piece, counters or bingo marker or highlighter pen.

Task Instructions:

Place the player marker anywhere on the outside track of the game. Roll the dice and move that many spaces around. The player should examine the value of the place value blocks on that space, and find the corresponding number in the inside. The large square pieces are 100's, the strips are 10's and the small squares are ones. Put a marker or colour in the square. The player plays until they achieve a "BINGO" of 5 in a row.
