Activity 2: Odds and Evens to 10

Materials Needed:

• Beans, cubes or counters; 10-frame from Activity 1

Task Instructions:

Using the 10 frame from the previous activity, hand your child a number of objects, from 1-10. Have them place them in the 10 frame, making sure to pair up where possible (see examples below). Ask them if all the objects can be paired? Then this is an EVEN number. If there is one without a partner, this is an ODD number. After a while, give them the objects and ask them to count, layout on the 10 frame, and say if the number is ODD or EVEN.
