Plant Senses

Plants respond to their environment in a variety of ways. Some common plant stimuli include light, gravity, water, movement of the sun, and touch.

Light

Plants kept inside a room always grow in the direction of the window. This is due to something called **phototropism**. This is when a plant grows towards the sun as that is its source of energy.

Touch

Plants use some defenses to help against predators or to keep us from touching them.

- 1. Thorns are on thistles
- 2. Prickles like on blackberries or roses
- 3. Spines are on cacti
- 4. Trichome has a poisonous fur under the leaf, like stinging nettle

Water

Plants have little pores (holes or openings) on the underside of their leaves, called stomata.

Plants will absorb **water** through their roots and release **water** as vapor into the air through these stomata.

Cool facts:

- 80-90% of a plant is water
- plants can live longer without food than water

Gravity

A plants response to gravity is called gravitropism.
