Explorations- Visual and Performing Arts Grades 4-5



BIRD AND FLOWER PAPER QUILLING

Students will learn about paper quilling as they make a bird and flower ring art picture.

WHAT YOU NEED:

- Construction paper
- White glue
- Scissors

WHAT YOU DO:

- 1. Cut a series of strips from the construction paper 1/2" wide.
- 2. Cut these strips to about 4" long. (Adults might want to do this step for younger children).

- 3. Encourage students to pinch the ends of rings to make either abstract shapes, or recognizable objects like flowers, leaves, etc.
- 4. Leave the rings round for animal bodies, the sun, and other round objects.
- 5. Students can adjust length of strips if desired, cutting them shorter for smaller things, and leaving them long (or gluing smaller pieces together) for larger items.
- 6. Students then glue these pieces to a sheet of construction paper to create images and designs.
