Grade Level: K-1

Curricular Area: Visual and Performing Arts



A DRAWING ADVENTURE

Students will create drawings based on an imaginary journey. This is a great warm up activity or 15 minute lesson. It will get your students' creative juices flowing!

WHAT YOU NEED:

- pencils
- paper
- pencil crayons or crayons or pastels or markers

WHAT YOU DO:

1. Ask your students to imagine that they are going on an adventure.
2. Ask your students the following questions:
 - “Where are you going on your adventure?” (a distant land, somewhere you’ve been before? a new place?)
 - “How will you get there?” (by car, plane, train, on foot, via a new mode of transportation?)
 - “Who will you see when you arrive?” (a friend? a family member? a creature? an alien?)
 - “What will you see on your adventure?”
3. Then, allow your students to draw their adventures!
