We are all authors and have a story to tell.

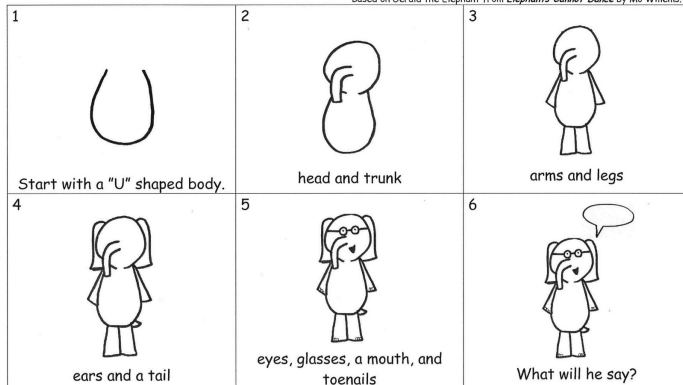


GATHER MATERIALS

- Writing tool - pen, pencil, felt, sharpie, etc.

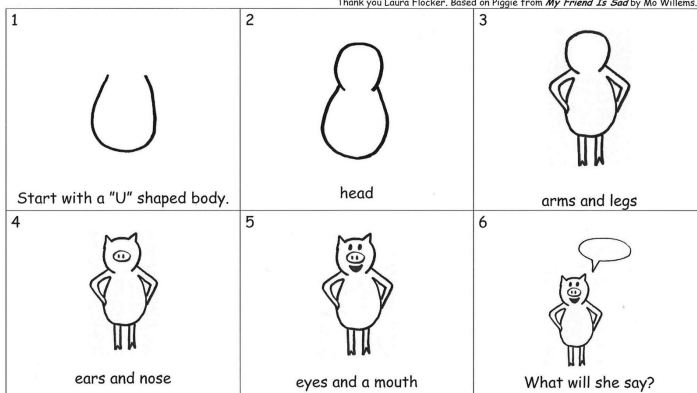
Elephant
