

Lesson 2: Parts of the Plot




Rising Action

The rising action are the events in the story that happen after the problem is introduced. Rising action leads to the climax of the story.

During the rising action the author will...

- Include events that build tension between characters
- Include problems and challenges that main character has to deal with
- Give hints to the reader of what the climax and resolution might be

When reading, think about the types of conflict your learned.




Climax

The climax is the most exciting or surprising part of the story and is sometimes known as the turning point.

At the climax, the author will...

- Surprise the reader
- Force the main character to face and deal with the problem or challenge in the story
- Create a change in the direction of the story line




Falling Action

Falling action refers to the events in the story that lead to the resolution or solution of the problem.

During the falling action, the author will...

- Start to move the main character towards reaching a solution to the problem.
- Decrease the tension in the story
- Start to answer questions the readers might have



Resolution

The resolution occurs at the end of the story. This is where the author provides a solution to the story and ties up any loose ends.

During the resolution, the author will...

- Share the solution to the problem
- Reveal the lesson the main characters learned
- Give the reader, closure OR share a plot twist for the next story
