Lesson 3: Characters

Protagonist vs. Antagonist

Most good fiction stories will have 2 important characters. A Protagonist and an antagonist.

Protagonist

The protagonist is the main character in the story. They are usually the hero at the end of the story.



Antagoníst

The antagonist is the bad/evil character in the story. They are usually in conflict with the protagonist.



Types of Characters

In a story, there are many types of characters that an author will add. Some impact the plot more than others.




We usually know a lot about round and dynamic characters. They are often the main characters and they go through change in the story.



Flat and static characters don't experience much change and the readers know very little about them. They do not impact the plot very much.

Finding Character Traits

Sometimes the author will say the traits of a character, but sometimes the reader will have to infer what a character's traits are through **actions, dialogue, feelings, and thoughts**.
