

**Grade Level:** K - 1

**Curriculum:** Exploration, ADST, Art

**Title of Lesson:** Ish!

**Learning Goals/Objectives:**

- Skills can be developed through play.
- People create art to express who they are as individuals and community.
- People connect to others and share ideas through the arts.

**Materials Needed:**

- Pencil
- Paper
- Colouring supplies

**Activity Instructions: (Step by Step)**

- [Follow this link to Tumblebooks](#) and search for the book, “Ish” by Peter H. Reynolds. Once you have watched or read along with the story, get out a piece of paper.
  - You are going to draw in the style of Ish! If you aren’t sure what to draw, watch the story again to get some inspiration!
  - Start with a couple simple things you have at your home, maybe a teddy bear-ish, or a table-ish, or a fork-ish.
  - Once you feel comfortable working as an artist-ish, we can try and draw some trickier things: emotions!
    - Think about some of the emotions you’ve explored with your Exploring Emotions activities. What are they? How do they look-ish?
      - Try to draw: Happy
        - Excited
        - Calm
        - Sadness
        - Angry
- Display your beautiful Ish drawings! Teach someone else at home how to draw in the style of ish!
