## Activity 2: Cat Up A Tree

Materials Needed:

- Borrow the book Cat Up A Tree (John and Ann Hassett) or look at the read-aloud here; small items such as beans or counters to represent the cats; paper and pencils/paints/colouring pencils to draw trees.

Task Instructions:


1. Read or listen to the book Cat Up A Tree. As you read or listen along, count out some beans to represent the cats each time. How many cats joined in the first cat?
2. After Nana Quimby sees 5 cats in the tree, how many cats join in each time? Act out the story using your beans or counters.
3. On a piece of paper, draw a tree with 5 branches like the one that had 5 cats in it. Arrange your counters so that there are the number of cats in each branch of the tree as in the table below. How many cats in total?
