Activity 2: Loose Tooth Adding

Materials Needed:

• 10 sided die (or use this <u>number generator</u>); grid below; counters of two different colours.

Task Instructions:

Roll the 10 sided dice (this can be played with a 6-sided dice if you don't have a 10 sided one); add 9 to the number rolled; put your counter on the total number on the grid. If there are no squares left with your total on it, you can cover up a tooth. Three in a line for one colour wins!




Parent tips:

This is a fluency game to practice the skill of adding 9. The strategy for adding 9 is to subtract one from the number rolled and add 10. So if you roll 6, 6 = 5 + 1...adding the 1 to the 9 makes 10, adding the the 5 to 10 makes the answer 15. This "making a friendly number" strategy is great to develop their mental math techniques.

LOOSE TOOTH ADDING!

ROLL THE 10 SIDED DICE (THIS CAN BE PLAYED WITH A 6-SIDED DICE IF YOU DON'T HAVE A 10 SIDED ONE); ADD 9 TO THE NUMBER ROLLED; PUT YOUR COUNTER ON THE TOTAL NUMBER ON THE GRID. IF THERE ARE NO SQUARES LEFT WITH YOUR TOTAL ON IT, YOU CAN COVER UP A TOOTH. THREE IN A LINE FOR ONE COLOUR WINS!
