

## **CURSIVE NAME ALIENS**


Students can turn their names – written in cursive – into aliens and monsters.


## **WHAT YOU NEED:**

- Paper
- Crayons
- chalk or pastel
- Large black marker
- Spoon or popsicle stick

## **WHAT YOU DO:**

- 1. Fold paper in half lengthwise and crease.
- 2. Open back up and write your name in cursive (important) large enough to take up most of the paper. An adult can write it for the child if necessary.
- 3. Trace the name heavily with chalk in a color that will show on the paper.
- 4. Refold the paper on the crease and rub over the paper with the back of the spoon or a popsicle stick.
- 5. Check inside to see if the name has transferred onto the other side of the sheet. If not, keep rubbing.
- 6. Open sheet and trace name with black marker.
- 7. Color in the resulting shapes with different colors. Usually there will be shapes that suggest eyes (maybe more than 2!) and antenna.
- 8. Continue to add details to your alien.
- 9. Make another one but this time turn it upside down and make the other end the head.
