

BLOCK OR NOT? (MONOPRINTING AND STAMPING)

Drawing, Printmaking

Students will use a monoprint stamp as a jumping off point for developing imagination and stimulating creativity.

WHAT YOU NEED:

- paper
- pencils
- a piece of polystyrene (rectangular shape)

- paint (only one color)
- paintbrush

WHAT YOU DO:

- 1. Use a paint brush to cover one side of the polystyrene piece with paint.
- 2. Stamp it onto paper.
- 3. Let dry.
- 4. Give each child a pencil.
- 5. Ask them use their imagination and create a composition trying to integrate the printed shape.
