

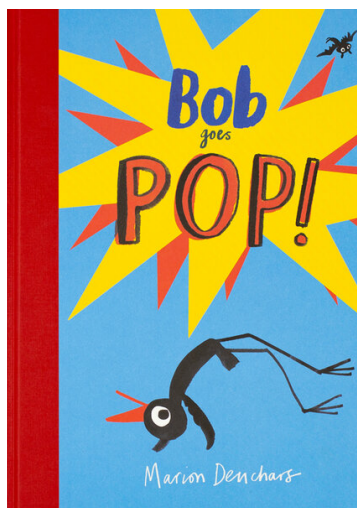

We are all authors and have a story to tell



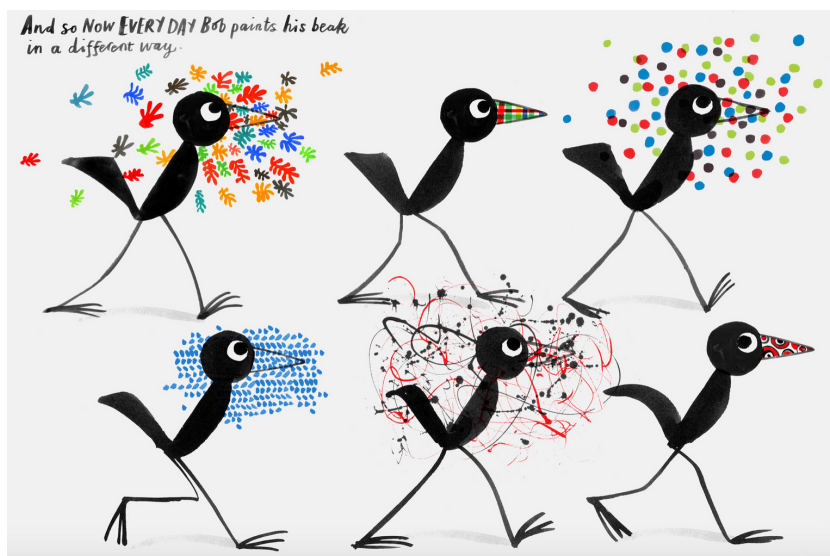
### GATHER MATERIALS

### CREATE AND SHARE

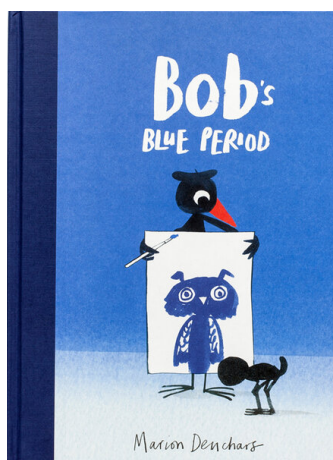
Draw along with Marion Deuchars as she shows you how she creates characters from her books :
