Materials:

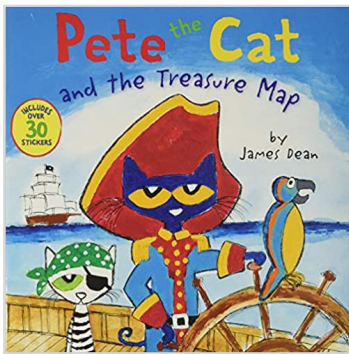
- Paper and pencil or notebook, crayons
