Activity 2: Making a Rule for Growing Patterns

Materials Needed:

- Pencil and paper, small objects to make patterns with or coloured pencils.

Task Instructions:

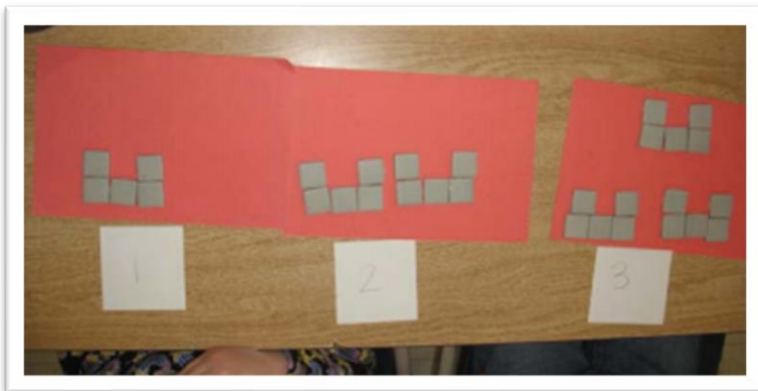
Now we are going to move from extending growing patterns to describing a general rule for how the patterns are growing.

For each of these tables of values, have your child fill in the missing numbers.

After they can do and understand these tables, have them create their own patterns, make a table of values for it, and then make a rule for the pattern. For example the bricks in the picture below are arranged as 5, 10, 15...the rule is to go up by 5 each time. Repeat.

Parent Tips:

These patterns will be easier for the student to understand if you use blocks or draw diagrams.

# of Parts	1	4	6	8	10	12	20	Double the number

# of Parts	5	7	9	11	13	15	23	Double the number and add 3
