

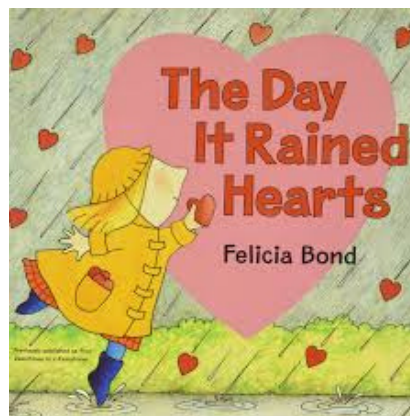
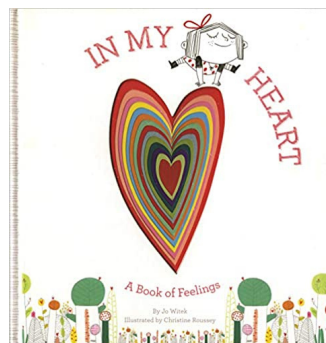
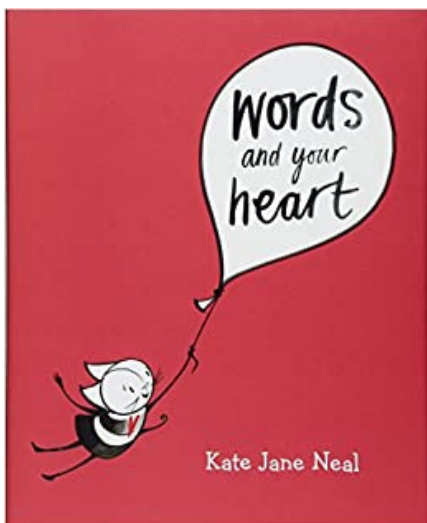
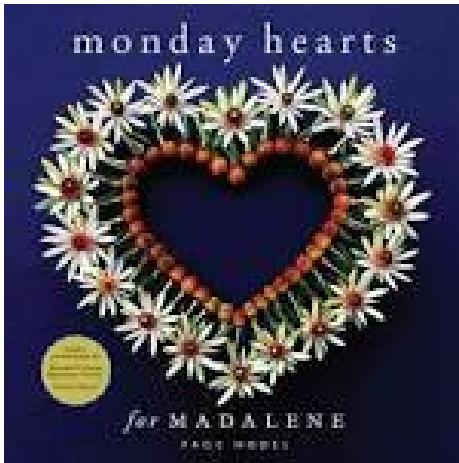
MONDAY HEARTS
