When you look outside your home, what do you see? Be specific.

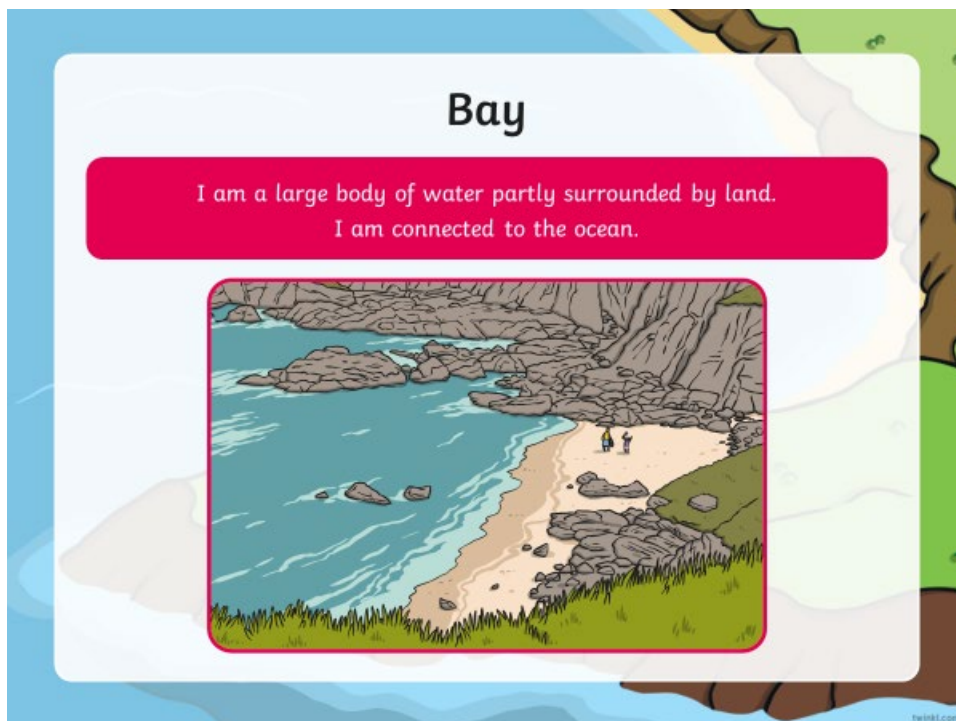
The land is very big so separating them into regions makes it easier to learn.

Beach

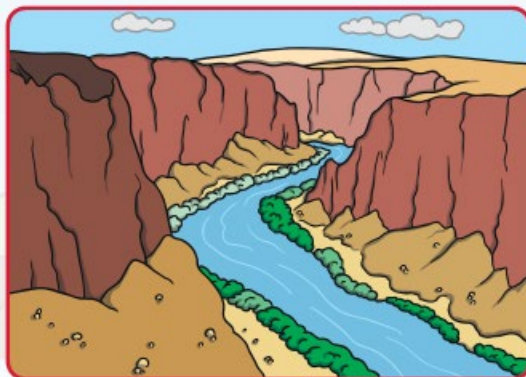
I am the shore of a body of water.

I am a very steep face of rock.



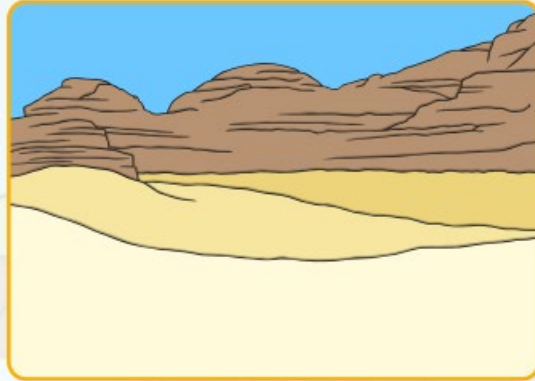
Delta

I am located at the mouth of a river. I am shaped like a triangle.



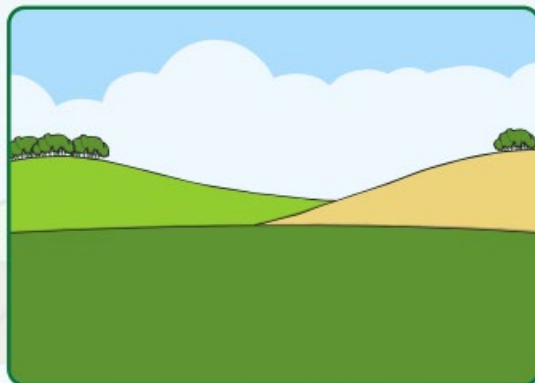
Desert

Mountain

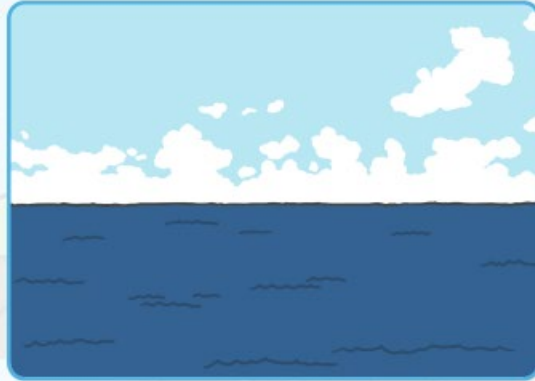
I am the tallest landform.

Ocean

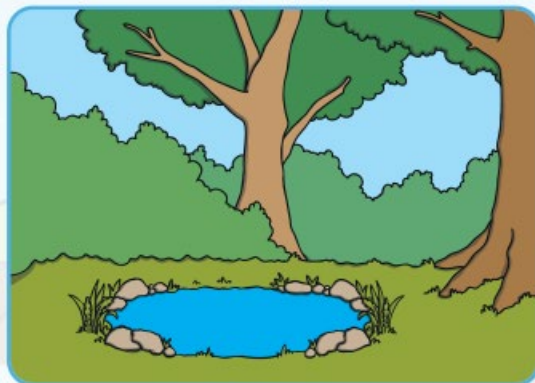
I am very large with lots of animals and plants inside me.

Pond

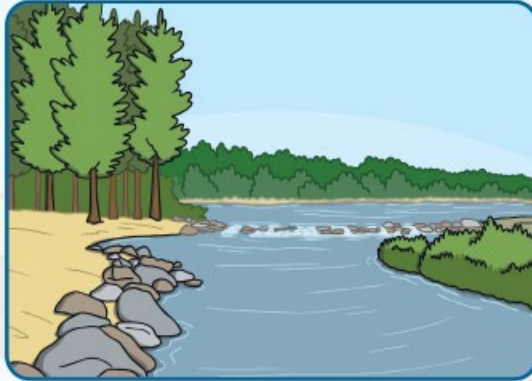
I am a small area of water,

River

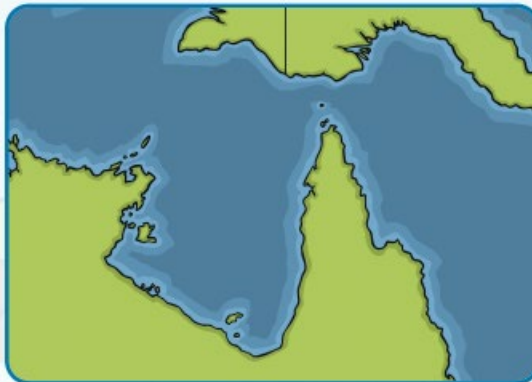
I am a flowing, moving stream of water that flows into an ocean, lake, pond, or other river.

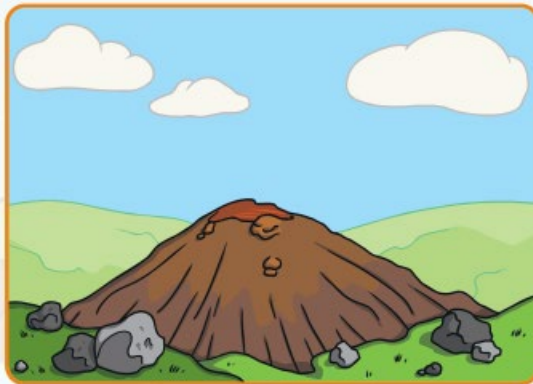
Valley
