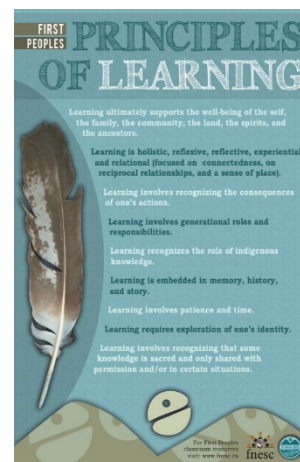
**Ask:**

First Peoples in Canada made some alterations to landscapes. However, it ultimately supports the well-being of the land. Alterations included construction of stone traps for fishing, establishment of clam gardens along the shore, and controlled burns of fields to help promote the growth of certain resources.
