

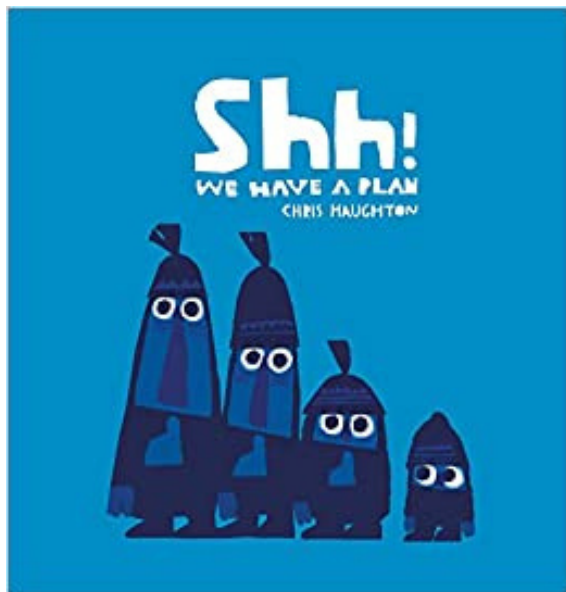

Language and story can be a source of creativity and joy.



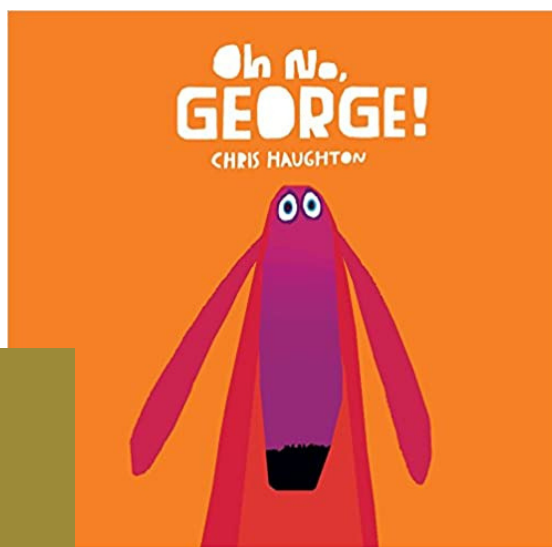
GATHER MATERIALS
