Activity 2: Maybe I Will...

Materials Needed:

- A pair of dice and cards from below.

Task Instructions:

Cut out the cards from pages 2 and 3.

Play this game with your child. Player A rolls 2 dice to sort out how much money they have. The first die names the tens. The second die names the ones.

Player B draws a card and shows it to Player A.

If Player A can afford it, they say "Maybe I will!" and takes the card. If they can't, that say "Oh no! I can't afford that!" and players switch turns.

The player with the most cards at the end of the game wins.

Summarize the thinking by saying:

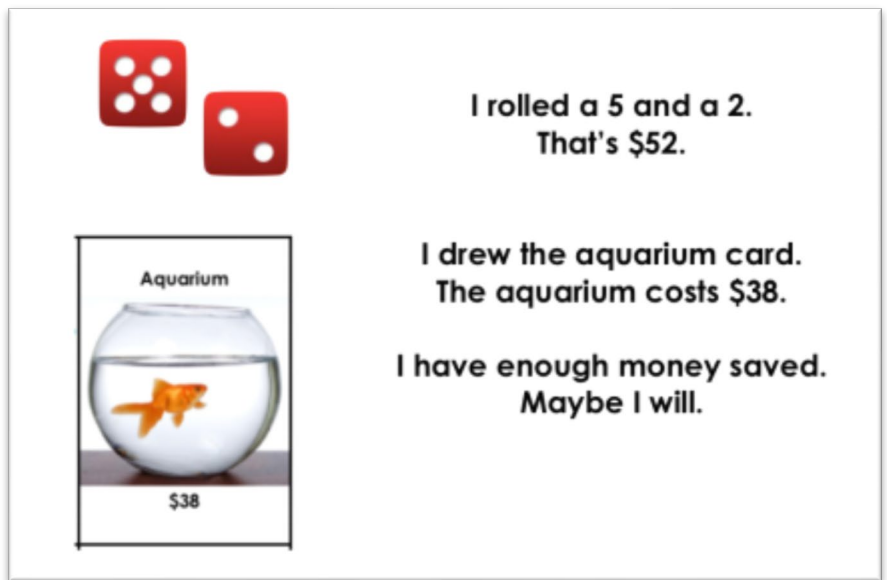
- We trade money to get objects or services.
- We make choices when we spend money.
- It's a good idea to share with others.
