Biomes - Rainforest

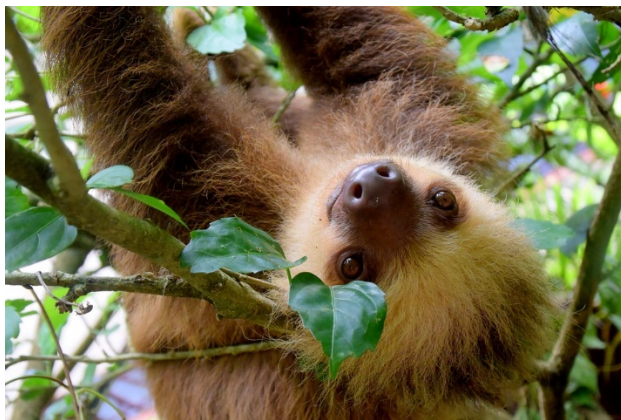

Cool Facts:

- Rainforests cover about 6% of the Earth's land surface
- It can take up to ten minutes for a raindrop to break through the thick trees and land on the ground
- About 15% of modern medicine ingredients come from rainforest plants.
- The rainforest gets an average of 12 feet of rain a year- that is about as high as your ceiling!
- Some pine trees can live to 2000 years
