Lesson Focus: Climate shapes how people live

Materials:

- Internet access for videos
- Notebook or paper and camera with video option, or ipad

Invitation to Learn:

Many factors impact climate and the climactic zones. People learn to adapt to climate where they live.

Ask:

- What are some climate factors you need to know about while living in Burnaby? Think about winter and summer. What differences do you notice between these time periods?
- What types of forests do we have in Burnaby and Vancouver?
- What zone is the North West Territories, or Yukon or Nunavut?
- How do people in the north adapt in winter conditions?
- What did you notice that was interesting about living in Nunavut?
- Do you notice trees in Nunavut? Why do you think?

Notebook Time:

Think about what you learned about how people live in the north and how they adapt to their climate. You will be creating an "explainer" video or story.

- 1. Create a script of information that you wish to share.
- 2. Draw the items that you will need to move around as you talk through your video. (If you are unsure, look at the first video. This can be your guide.)
- 3. You may colour your items or not.
- 4. Practice your script before you record your video.
- 5. Record your video and show it to someone in your family.
