**Biomes – Temperature Deciduous Forest**

The temperate deciduous forest is a biome that is always changing. It has four distinct seasons: winter, spring, summer and fall. Winters are cold and summers are warm.

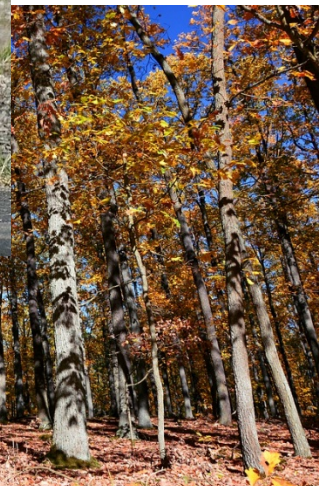
This biome has 4 seasons.

- Black bears, wolves, and coyotes are very common animals that live in the temperate deciduous forest biome.
- Deciduous is a Latin word that means "to fall off".
- A single oak tree can produce 90,000 acorns in one year.
